
Accreditation Centre Size


In principle, accreditation centres should be set-up near each stadium and in the FIFA Headquarters. Ideally, each stadium's centre should be located outside, but along the exterior perimeter line of the stadium so as to allow access in order for persons to be processed and accredited.

The centres have to be of adequate size so that large numbers of people can be accredited according to the various categories; the size of the accreditation centres ideally should be approx. between 150 - 225m2. If such a contiguous space is not available then a proper alternative can be discussed. TVs, tables and chairs, and high speed Internet are required. The Internet connection should have at a minimum 2 Mb downstream and 512 Kb upstream speed.
